Item	Description
Outer jackets and coats	Plain black coat. No hoodies. Discreet logos.
Blue Sedgehill blazer*	Navy blue with school crest *
Pullover*	Navy jumper with blue stripe*
Blue school shirt/blouse	Blue shirt with collar (top button fastened, shirt tucked in).
Sedgehill Tartan skirt*	Navy Tartan skirt* (knee length). These are not to be rolled over.
Sedgehill trousers*	Navy school trousers with Sedgehill logo* (no skinny fit).
Belt	Plain black belt (no large buckle).
Socks and tights	Plain black ankle socks or plain black tights
Shoes	Plain black polishable shoes (with black laces if needed). No patent shoes, trainers, canvas shoes or boots above the ankle, only Kickers style.
Rucksack*	Blue Sedgehill rucksack. We will provide these for every student free of charge.
Sedgehill Tie*	Sedgehill school tie

Personal Presentation

We expect students to reflect our high standards in their own appearance too.

- > Uniform must be worn correctly at all times it is worn, including to and from school.
- > Hair must be neat, tidy and with no colouring or coloured extensions. Patterns, shapes, uneven cuts, fades or shaved partings are not allowed in the hair or in eyebrows.
- > Nail polish, false nails or lashes are not allowed.
- > Make-up is also not allowed.
- > Jewellery should not be worn other than watches. If students have pierced ears, only one pair of small (<3mm), discreet studs are allowed. No nose rings or other piercings allowed.
- > Facial piercings and shaved eyebrows are also not allowed.
- > No scarves are to be worn except where required by religion.
- > Ties should be worn appropriately with a minimum of 7 stripes showing.
- > Top buttons should be fastened at all times. No extra items are to be worn.

Image and presentation matter and it is vital that our students take pride in their appearance and represent themselves, their families and the school well.

Equipment and Valuables

Equipment

Students should bring their school bag with them each day in order to carry their books, writing equipment and sports kit. Every student is expected to bring the following basic items of equipment to every lesson:

- > Planner – we provide
- > Reading Book
- > Pencil case – see through
- > Black pen x2
- > Pencils x 2
- > Ruler 30cm clear plastic
- > Rubber/eraser
- > Sharpener
- > Green pen x2
- > Whiteboard Pen and foam rubber
- > Highlighter
- > Scientific Calculator - we recommend Casio FX85GTX or FX83GTX (available to purchase from school for £10)
- > Glue stick

Textbooks and specialist equipment will be issued on loan and students will be required to pay for any loss or damage to school property.

All equipment can be bought from the main school office for £15.

Valuables

Please do not allow your child to bring expensive items or large sums of money into the school. Mobile phones and personal entertainment equipment are not to be seen in the school. If seen or allowed to disrupt learning, they will be confiscated and will be returned only at the end of the day. The school does not accept any responsibility for the loss or replacement of any items which ought not to be seen in the school. In some cases, parents/carers will need to collect confiscated phones in person and students may be asked to hand in their phone for safe keeping during the school day.
